Our P&C AGM will be held on Wednesday 8 March at 6pm in our Primary Staffroom. I would encourage all parents to become involved. I hope to see you there.

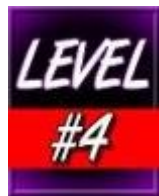
